Day 1: Delhi

On arrival at Delhi airport you will be met by our representative and transferred to hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel.



Day 2: Delhi

Morning half day city tour of Old Delhi visiting Raj Ghat - The Mausoleum of Mahatma Gandhi. Jama Masjid - the biggest Mosque in India and drive past Red Fort and tricycle tour of Chandni Chowk. Afternoon half day city tour of New Delhi. Drive past President House, Parliament House (House of Representatives) and India Gate - War Memorial (stop for photography), Qutub Minar - 72.55 meters, high



Victory Tower, onto Bahai Temple (lotus temple) Humayun's Tomb- built of red sandstone and is a first substantial example of the Mughal architecture, Laxmi Narayan Temple - a modern Hindu temple built by the Birlas, leading Indian industrialists. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 3: Delhi - Agra

Morning drive to Agra, the city of the TAJ and up on arrival, check in at the hotel. Taj Mahal built by Mughal Emperor Shah Jehan in the year 1652 as a memorial for his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal. The grandeur called the Taj is perhaps the most photographed, filmed, described and sketched building of the world. Taj Mahal is where fantasy coincides with reality in perfect harmony. An inspiration for



innumerable artists over the centuries, the Taj is an ode to love. It took 22 years to create this jewel. Agra Fort built and renovated over the centuries, this massive fort gained recognition only during the Mughal reign. Tomb of Itmad-ud-daulah- built by Empress Noorjehan in the memory of her father. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 4: Agra - Fatehpur Sikri - Jaipur

Morning drive to Jaipur - the pink city of India. The capital of Rajasthan was given a colour coat of pink, a century ago in the honour of a visiting Prince, ever since it has retained the pink colour. En-route visit Fatehpur - Sikri (40 kms. from Agra) - once the capital of Mughal Empire and abandoned after 15 years due to scarcity of water. Its fortifications and Palaces are in a wonderful state



of preservation. Upon arrival check-in at hotel. A Traditional Maharaja Welcome at the hotel. Afternoon city tour visiting City Palace - where the former Maharaja still resides in a part of it, but the rest now serves as a Museum. Also visit Jantar Mantar, an observatory built by a great astronomer Sawai Jai Singh. Drive past through Hawa Mahal (Palace of winds).

Day 5: Jaipur

Morning visit Amber Fort-remarkable for the majestic grandeur of its surroundings as for its sturdy battlements and beautiful palaces. Climb up to the fort on the back of an Elephant or by jeep. A Gala Rajasthani Theme Dinner. Overnight stay at hotel.

**Day 6: Jaipur - Goa**

Morning after breakfast transfer to the airport for flight to Goa via Mumbai. Upon arrival at Goa, transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**Day 7: Goa**

Morning after breakfast half day visit to Panjim City. Panjim, a former fishing Village, was made the capital of Goa by royal decree from the court of Lisbon. It's spread around "Altinho" meaning hillock, a residential area with Portuguese style bungalows where the dominant structure is the Patriarch's Palace with the statue of Christ the King on its lawns. From Altinho one gets a panoramic



view of Panjim. The oldest monument in Panjim is the Idalco or Adil Shah's Palace built in 1490 and there is also the beautiful Church of our Lady of Immaculate Conception. Afternoon relax on the beach. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 8: Goa

Breakfast at the hotel. Day at leisure on the beach. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**Day 9: Goa - Mumbai**

After breakfast morning at leisure on the beach. Later, transfer to the airport for flight to Mumbai. Upon arrival, proceed directly for a short city orientation of Mumbai. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**Day 10: Mumbai**

Morning after breakfast transfer to International airport for onward destination.
