

Ladakh With North India Tour (15 Days/ 14 Nights)

Delhi-Leh-Delhi-Agra-Jaipur-Udaipur-Delhi-Kullu-Manali-Naggar-Manali-Dharamshala-Chandigarh-Delhi

Popularly known as "Hermit Kingdom", Ladakh is a land of snow carved peaks, translucent Lakes, barren terrain and mystic culture. Apart from Himachal is Switzerland of India. Himachal Pradesh has some of the most spectacular and beautiful landscapes. It has lofty snow peaks, deep gorges, lush green valleys, beautiful temples and monasteries. The capital of this beautiful state is Shimla and other hill stations include Kullu, Manali.

Day 1: Delhi

Arrive at Delhi international airport, met and greeted by our representative and transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.



Day 2: Delhi - Leh

After breakfast on time assistance and transfer to domestic airport for connecting flight to Leh. Arrive Leh, meet and assistance and transfer to hotel. Rest of the day free to acclimatize to the high altitude of Ladakh. Late after noon visit Shankar Gumpa. Sankar Gumpa of Ladakh is located at a distance of approximately 3 km from the town of Leh. A subsidiary of the Spituk Gumpa, it belongs to the Gelukpa or the Yellow Hat Sect. The monastery also serves as the official residence of the Ladakh's head of Gelukpa Sect, known as The Kushok Bakul. Overnight stay at hotel.



Day 3: Leh

After breakfast, visit Spituk, Phiyang, Alchi Gumpa. Phiyang Monastery of Ladakh is situated at a distance of approximately 40 km to the west of the Leh town. It belongs to the Red Hat Sect of Buddhism. Overnight stay at hotel.



Day 4: Leh

After breakfast, visit Shey, Thiksey & Hemis Monastery - Shey Gumpa of Ladakh is situated on a hillock, at a distance of approximately 15 km to the south of Leh town. Thiksey Gumpa of Ladakh is situated at a distance of approximately 18 km from the town of Leh. One of the most beautiful monasteries of Ladakh, it belongs to the Gelukpa Order of Buddhism. Hemis Monastery holds the distinction of being the biggest as well as the wealthiest monastery of Ladakh. Hemis Monastery is positioned inside a gorge, at a distance of approximately 47 km from Leh. Overnight stay at hotel.



Day 5: Leh - Delhi - Agra

After breakfast, transfer to domestic airport to board flight to Delhi. Arrive Delhi, meet-assist & then drive to Agra, {a covering distance of 200kms & 4 hours}, arrive Agra, check in to Hotel. Afternoon sightseeing of Agra Fort & Sunset visit of Taj Mahal (closed on Friday). Overnight stay at hotel.



Day 6: Agra - Jaipur

After breakfast Sightseeing of Itmad-ud-daulah's Tomb, to the north of the fort, on the opposite bank of the Yamuna lies the tomb of Itmad-ud-daulah, built in memory of Mirza Ghiyas Beg, Jehangir's wazir. Later visit Jaipur via Fatehpur Sikri. Overnight stay at hotel.



Day 7: Jaipur

After breakfast, Excursion to Amber Fort & Joy the Elephant / Jeep ride upto the hills - Amber Fort: Situated about 11 km out of Jaipur on the Delhi to Jaipur road, Amber was once the ancient capital of Jaipur state. Later City sightseeing pink city of Jaipur - Jaipur city is known for its many palaces and forts, which are a major attraction for tourists to Rajasthan. City Palace: The palace is a blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture. Jantar Mantar: Raja Jai Singh built this observatory, begun by Jai Singh in 1728 Hawa Mahal :(See The View From Outside). Overnight Stay.



Day 8: Jaipur - Udaipur

On time assistance and transfer to Jaipur airport to board flight to Udaipur by 9W -3401 Dep 0715 Hrs / Arr 0810 Hrs. On arrival assistance and transfer to Hotel. Later Proceed for sightseeing tour of Udaipur, stopping first at City Palace. Here you will marvel at rooms with mirrored walls and ivory doors, colored glass windows and inlaid marble balconies and the Peacock Courtyard. Proceed for Evening Motor launch cruise on the placid waters of Lake Pichola. Spend some time at the Jag Mandir Palace. Overnight stay.



Day 9: Udaipur - Delhi

On time assistance and transfer to Udaipur airport to board flight to Delhi. On arrival assistance and transfer to Hotel. After NOON Sightseeing of Old Delhi-Red Fort (Closed on Monday), Laxmi Narayan Temple, India Gate & Humayun's Tomb. Overnight stay at hotel.



Day 10: Delhi - Kullu - Manali

After breakfast, on time assistance and transfer to Delhi Airport for flight to Kullu. Arrive Kullu and drive to Manali. On arrival check-in to hotel. Later free for own activities. Overnight stay at hotel.



Day 11: Naggar - Manali

After breakfast full day visit of Manali, Naggar and Roerich Museum Roerich Art Gallery, Naggar embraced stupendous quality. HADIMBA TEMPLE Built in 1553, this four-storey wooden Hadimba or Dhungri temple is famous for its exquisitely carved doorway. It is located in the middle of a forest called the -Dhungiri Van Vihar-. Overnight stay



Day 12: Manali - Dharamshala

After breakfast drive to Dharamshala, after arrival check in to your respective hotel. Overnight at hotel.



Day 13: Dharamshala

Visit Dharamshala - Two and a half millennia after the Buddha walked on earth, another walks in his foot steps." Welcome to Dharamshala, the land of Dalai Lama, a charming little town with elegant bungalows. Overnight stay.



Day 14: Dharamshala - Chandigarh - Delhi

After breakfast, drive to Chandigarh railway station Approx 250 Kms 07 Hours drive for Board train to Delhi By shatabdi Express. Arrive Delhi and transfer to international airport for onward destination.
